On the 22nd of Tishrei 5784 (October 7, 2023), she charged towards terrorists in the Zikim base and saved dozens of soldiers and civilians. She fell in battle at the age of 20, and buried in the military cemetery in Nahariya. She left parents, two brothers, and a sister.

Oriya grew up in the Gilo neighborhood of Jerusalem, in the Beit Yisrael community. He was a member of and counselor in Bnei Akiva, a social activist, graduate of the Chanaton pre-military academy, and a soldier full of drive and light. For more than 100 days of fighting in Gaza, he fought with courage and faith.

On the 7th of Shvat 5784 (January 17, 2024), he fell in battle in Khan Yunis, aged 21. He was buried in the military cemetery on Mount Herzl, Jerusalem. He left parents, a brother and a sister.
