



Game Instructions

The facilitator will divide the group into three or five teams, depending on the number of participants.

Stage 1 – choosing elements: 5-10 minutes

At the beginning of the game, each team in turn chooses one element until all the elements have been distributed.

Stage 2 – use the game cards for about 50-60 minutes

- 5 "Find the Connection" cards
- 10 "Carrying the Gurney" (active tasks)
- 5 Dilemma Cards (see instruction manual)

Put the triangular cards on each other in a way that creates a Magen David.

Shuffle the cards so that participants pick up a different type of card each turn.

Each group in turn picks up a card and follows the instructions on it: Find a connection between the different elements/ active task/ discussion or dilemma solution.

*The length of the game is flexible and subject to the facilitator's decision. You can play with all or some of the cards, depending on the age and character of the teams.

Game Rules

The teams that possess element/s noted on the "Find the Connection" cards should place them on the central board. A team that does not have at least one of the elements can select an element from those it has, add it to the board, and participate.

The facilitator declares "**Let's Go!**" and from that moment, the teams participating in the round have 1.5 minutes to think of an example of mutual responsibility, created from a combination of all the elements on the board.

The team that feels ready will shout out "**mutual responsibility**" and present its 'connection' story for about a minute. The first team to establish a successful connection between the various elements / to perform the task on the task cards well / to offer a solution to the dilemma will receive a "good deed" coin. The goal is to collect as many coins as possible.

After carrying out the "Find the Connection" and "Carrying the Gurney" tasks, read out the "Worth Knowing" info on the other side of the cards.


Stage 3 – Conclusion: Approximately 10 minutes







The percentage of IDF enlistment among reserve soldiers in the "Iron Swords" War was very high (almost 100%). Among the recruits are those not supposed to enlist because of their age. The fighting was characterized by a tremendous fighting spirit.

"Iron Swords" began following the surprise terrorist attack on Israel, carried out by terrorist organizations from the Gaza Strip, led by Hamas, on October 7, 2023, on the morning of Shabbat, Simchat Torah, 22 Tishrei 5784.

In the wake of the war, the KKL-JNF initiated many projects designed to help in various areas and to support national resilience, increasing emergency assistance to alert squads and town defense.

- The launch of "The Way of Heroes" in Ofakim Park to commemorate the heroism of Israeli women, who saved the lives of dozens of people during the brutal October 7, 2023 attack.
- KKL-JNF employees donated over a million shekels from their vacation days to purchase equipment and food for IDF soldiers.

- Thousands of evacuated families went on organized trips throughout Israel and had a brief respite from the war.
- "City of Shelter" – KKL, KKL-JNF-UK, and "Osim Shechuna" (NGO), together with the Pre-Military College Council and the Community Centers Association, have made thousands of bomb shelters usable throughout the country.



Mutual responsibility is considered one of the central values in Judaism, expressing unity and solidarity among the Jewish people. The term "mutual responsibility" is mentioned in the Talmud – "all of Israel are responsible for each other" (Shavuot 39a). Statistics indicate that more than 50% of the Israeli public volunteers or is socially involved.

Benefits of Mutual Responsibility: A sense of belonging, personal resilience, developing social skills, the ability to achieve greater goals, contributing to the environment, and more. People who feel part of a supportive group enjoy better health and a sense of purpose in life.

Task:

The facilitator tells the participants they have 5 seconds to write a flattering compliment to a person on their right. He/she counts from 1-5 and then each participant gives the compliment to the person on his or her right.

In the book of proverbs, we read "Death and life in the hand of the tongue." A good word spoken by one person to another conveys a message of appreciation and responds to the need to feel valued and a sense of belonging.

During the Hamas attack, many civilians left their families during the holiday and rushed south, risking their lives in battle to rescue residents of the Gaza Envelope communities and from the Nova Festival, a nature party of some 4,400 partygoers.

One example was Elchanan and Menachem Kalmanzon and their nephew Itiel, who set up an armed civilian rescue team,

entering the inferno in Kibbutz Beeri and saving dozens of civilians, until a bullet hit and killed Elchanan. For their work in holding back the massacre and rescuing civilians, the team won the Israel Prize for civilian heroism and mutual responsibility for 5784 (2024). (Recommended reading: Menachem's moving speech at the ceremony. See instruction manual.)

Task:

How Do We Get out of This? With their right hand, each participant holds the left hand of another participant (but not the hand of the person next to him/her) and with their left hand, the right hand of another participant.

Now, you're connected in a circle, but it's complicated and convoluted. You need to untie the human knots without letting your hands go, and form a regular circle.

* For the facilitator - you can use a stopwatch and try to untangle within a specified time.

During the "Iron Swords" War, community managers, assisted by youth movements and volunteers, initiated special activities for evacuated residents and families. They set up armed neighborhood civilian alert teams and made shelters usable.

Many assisted in transporting soldiers, raising funds, education, agriculture and more. (Many farms were damaged during

the Hamas attack. Some farmers were injured by terrorists or were called up to the reserves, and many foreign workers left, so there was an urgent need for volunteers.)

Once the Hamas attack became known, Israeli emissaries from around the world, Israelis exempt from reserve duty, and many Israeli citizens on vacation, returned to Israel to enlist.

Task:

The facilitator asks for six volunteers. Three of them will be blindfolded. The other three will have to lead them, with verbal instructions, from one side of the room to the other, without bumping into anything.

At the end of the exercise, we ask: How did you feel? Did you trust those leading you? How did the three leaders feel?

If there is enough space in the room, everyone can try it out.

shortly after Hamas' surprise attack, educators and therapists organized themselves to help the wounded and evacuees. They established voluntary complexes in hotels where the evacuees were staying to provide an initial emotional response and educational frameworks for the children.

Many therapists met independently with survivors of the Nova Music Festival, in which 364 people were murdered near Kibbutz Reim.

The Secret Forest resort, owned by an Israeli and located in a nature reserve in Cyprus, invited survivors for a few days, including free treatments.

During the "Iron Swords" War, the KKL-JNF planted trees in honor of the children returned from Hamas captivity in Gaza. Planting trees symbolizes rebirth.

364 trees were planted in memory of the murdered at the Nova Music Festival.

The KKL-JNF is the largest green organization in Israel. One of its main functions is planting trees and developing forests and parks.

Israel is one of the only countries in the world that has more trees today than it did a century ago. Trees create shade and a comfortable climate, reducing the amount of carbon dioxide in the atmosphere and thereby reducing global warming.

Since the outbreak of the "Iron Swords" War, restaurants, organizations and individuals have been providing evacuated families and soldiers with fresh food. For example, Basama Hano, a military widow from Nur, a Druze restaurant, sent hundreds of rations to soldiers every weekend. "I don't think twice about my country. Cooking for soldiers is my

mission." "Connecting to the Soul" (NGO), which provides food for 10,000 families in need, also stepped up to organize sandwiches, treats, toiletries and more for soldiers.

Many donations were designated for activities for evacuees, alert teams, treats for soldiers, and more.

Many volunteers – and particularly during “Iron Swords” – take part in Israel's PR efforts. Among them is Linor Abergil, Miss Israel 1998, who is trying to raise international awareness of Hamas' crimes in general and their sexual abuse of women in particular. Singer Eden Golan represented Israel in the Eurovision Song Contest 2024 with her song “Hurricane” and Yossef Hadad, an Israeli Christian Israeli Arab who fought and was wounded

in the Second Lebanon War, and who lit a torch at Israel's 76th Independence Day ceremony, is a prominent social media activist and the CEO of Together – Responsible for Each Other, which works to connect Arab society to Israeli society.

During the war, Israeli flags were hung throughout cities, on private balconies, on the walls of public institutions and in business complexes. Many companies also integrated a flag into the design of their apps. In addition, during funeral processions for IDF soldiers, many Israelis wave Israeli flags and accompany the families of the fallen.

In September 2023, a new Guinness World Record was set: the largest 3D Israeli flag in the world! 11th grade students from the Atid High School in Beersheva created a flag of more than 1,000 parts, measuring 3.5m by 5m. The flag is displayed in a museum in Beersheva.

Discussion:

252 civilians and soldiers, including infants, children, teenage girls and the elderly, were abducted to the Gaza Strip. They joined the four civilians and soldiers abducted by Hamas in the past decade. So far, 116 abductees have been returned alive, 62 murdered, 19 bodies have been returned for burial, and (as of June 2024) 120 are still in captivity. Should the hostages be released at all costs?
